Program Outlook:

- The Nails Specialty Program provides students with the technical knowledge and skills for employment as a licensed manicurist and pedicurist. Instruction is designed to qualify students for employment upon successfully obtaining a Nails Specialty Certification. Instruction includes a combination of classroom theory and practical experiences through practice on mannequins and patrons in the lab.

Program Content:

- Florida cosmetology laws and rules
- Safe and efficient work practices
- Related chemistry, bacteriology, anatomy, and physiology
- Skin care and manicuring
- Preparation for Nails Specialty Certification
- Employability skills & entrepreneurship



Industry Certification:

- The State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation License

Length of Program:

- The average length of this program is 240 hours (approx. 3 months) for adults attending full-time. Actual time is dependent upon enrollment (full-time/part-time) and the length of time the student requires to achieve competencies.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Interview by a counselor
- Adult students must be at least 16 years old and not attending high school
- Fees for supplies and textbooks required
